Responsibilities include:

- > Determining and implementing academic accommodations
- > Coordinating financial aid and adaptive technology.

Success in this position will entail a thorough knowledge of the principles and practices of vocational rehabilitation, as well as demonstrated skill in the areas of education and career counseling, including knowledge of labour market trends. Knowledge of learning disability assessments would be an asset.

- > Knowledge of tests used in learning disability assessments, the ability to evaluate them critically, training in measurement, psychometrics, and learning disability assessment would be assets.
